



She is now in a sober living home and recently called to let her case manager know she is **employed**, **sober**, and has started **attending church each Sunday**.

Safe Spaces: Emergency shelter and rental support for those fleeing abuse.

Legal Help: Support with prosecuting traffickers, legal advocacy, and immigration assistance.

Essential Items: Clothing, toiletries, furniture, and other basic needs for survivors and families.

Medical Care:

Access/transportation to doctors, dental care, and mental health counseling.

Transportation: Rideshare assistance for those fleeing an abusive situation.


