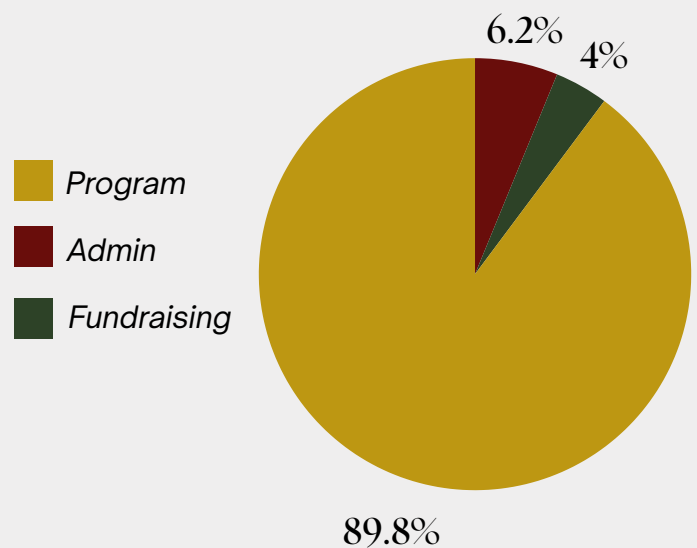

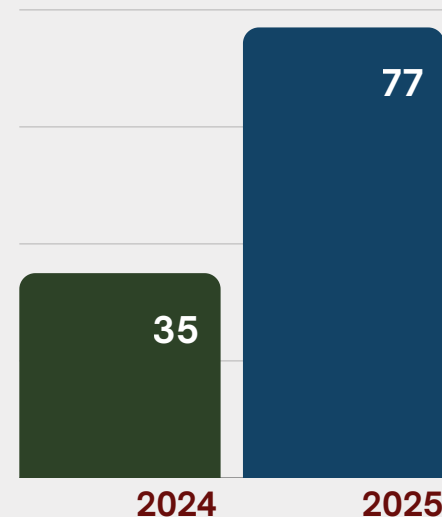

Carol is a long-term **TFP** client who was a victim of sex trafficking.  
She was **referred** to us by the **Hope Center**.

During her trafficking, Carol was unhoused and living in an encampment for over a year.  
TFP provided her with **emergency shelter** for a month.

She is now in a sober living home and recently called to let her case manager know she is **employed, sober, and has started attending church each Sunday**.

## BECAUSE OF YOU: WHAT SURVIVORS RECEIVE THROUGH TFP...

**Safe Spaces:** Emergency shelter and rental support for those fleeing abuse.

**Legal Help:** Support with prosecuting traffickers, legal advocacy, and immigration assistance.

**Essential Items:** Clothing, toiletries, furniture, and other basic needs for survivors and families.

**Medical Care:** Access/transportation to doctors, dental care, and mental health counseling.

**Transportation:** Rideshare assistance for those fleeing an abusive situation.

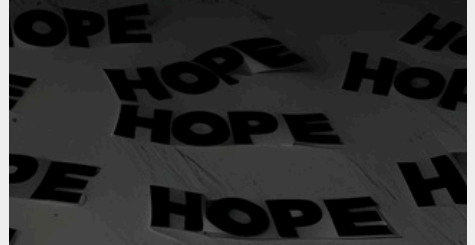

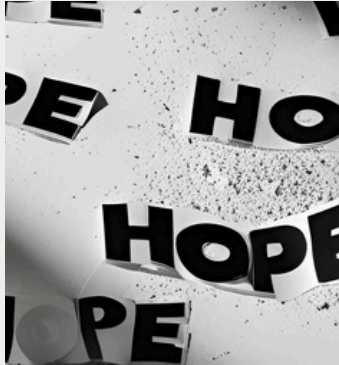
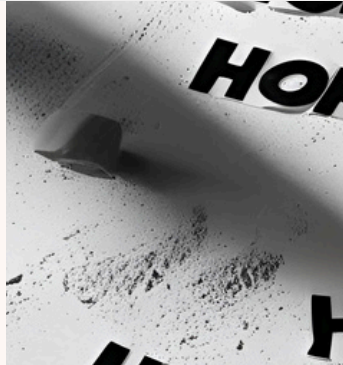
